

Bureau of Economic Analysis Mandatory 2014 BE-10 Survey Reporting Requirement Deadline Approaches

The Bureau of Economic Analysis of the U.S. Department of Commerce requires all U.S. persons that own or control more than 10 percent of the voting securities (a "*Direct Investment*") of a "foreign" business enterprise to report on its BE-10 Benchmark Survey of U.S. Direct Investment Abroad for the fiscal year 2014. Form BE-10 is due by May 29, 2015, for respondents reporting fewer than 50 Foreign Affiliate forms (as discussed below) and June 30, 2015, for 50 or more forms.
